REGULATION NO. 2005/5

**ON THE PROMULGATION
OF THE LAW ON GAMES OF CHANCE
ADOPTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF KOSOVO**

The Special Representative of the Secretary-General,

Pursuant to the Authority given to him under United Nations Security Council resolution 1244 (1999) of 10 June 1999,

In conformity with Chapter 8 and sections 9.1.44 and 9.1.45 of the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo (UNMIK Regulation No. 2001/9 of 15 May 2001),

Taking into account a communication from the President of the Assembly of Kosovo, dated 28 September 2004, concerning the Law on Games of Chance adopted by the Assembly on 8 September 2004,

Noting that the provisions of the Law shall be without prejudice to the authority of the Special Representative of the Secretary-General under United Nations Security Council resolution 1244 (1999) or his reserved powers and responsibilities under the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo,

Hereby promulgates, effective as of the date of signature, the Law on Games of Chance adopted by the Assembly of Kosovo (Law No. 2004/35) attached to the present Regulation, provided that the term "Penal Provisions" in the title of Chapter VII shall be deleted and replaced by "Administrative Sanctions", and the word "penalized" in article 59.2 shall be deleted and replaced by "fined". These changes shall be reflected in the final official text of the Law
